

NORTH LAS VEGAS POLICE DEPARTMENT DEMOGRAPHICS REPORT

The North Las Vegas Police Department was founded in 1946 with an original jurisdiction of nearly 4 square miles and a population of approximately 3,000. It now services 100.48 square miles¹ with a population of approximately 233,808². The North Las Vegas Police Department, consisting of 292 commissioned personnel and 104 civilian personnel, currently employs a total of 396 full time employees.

Statistics show that there are 1.24 Police Officers per 1,000 residents.

The ethnicity breakdown below pertains to commissioned and full time civilian personnel:
