

NORTH LAS VEGAS POLICE DEPARTMENT DEMOGRAPHICS REPORT

The North Las Vegas Police Department was founded in 1946 with an original jurisdiction of nearly 4 square miles and a population of approximately 3,000. It now services 100.48 square miles¹ with a population of approximately 233,808². The North Las Vegas Police Department, consisting of Police, Detention and Marshal Warrant Services, currently employs a total of 411 full time employees (304 commissioned personnel and 107 civilian personnel). The commissioned staff consists of 267 police personnel, 29 detention personnel and 8 marshal personnel. The civilian staff consists of 107 full time employees.

Statistics show that there are 1.13 Police Officers per 1,000 residents.
