The purpose of this addendum is to answer questions/issues discussed at the Pre-Proposal conference.

QUESTION 1:

It is stated in the Scope of Work that the generators, power boxes and light towers can only be operated by a licensed electrician. Would Certified Technicians be able to be used in place of?

Answer: Yes, Certified Technicians or Licensed electricians can operate the generators, power boxes and light towers.

QUESTION 2:

Will schematics be provided for this proposal?

Answer: No, the schematics for past events might not capture the schematic required for this year's events. Schematics will be provided to the successful vendor prior to the event.

QUESTION 3:

What are the operating event hours for the 3 events?

**Answer: Taste & Tunes- 17 Operating Event Hours to include 2-3 hours of testing. In addition some generators will need to run for 24 hours.
Independence Day- 7 Operating Event Hours to include 1-2 hours of testing.
Balloonapalooza- 35 Operating Event Hours , miscellaneous hours of testing prior to event, some generators will need to run for 24 hour periods.**
