

NOTICE OF POTENTIAL BUSINESS IMPACT

The City of North Las Vegas ("City") is proposing to repeal Title 8, Chapter 20 of the North Las Vegas Municipal Code regulating the collection, transportation, deposit and disposal of solid waste, recyclables and replacing the same with new regulations governing the collection, transportation, deposit and disposal of solid waste, recyclables, and other related matters. The City has not substantially updated its current solid waste regulations since 1988, and has determined such regulations were in need of significant revision, restructuring, and modernization in order to meet the needs of the City, its residents, and the business community.

Nevada Revised Statute ("NRS") Sections 237.030 through 237.110 require the City to "consult with trade associations or owners and officers of businesses that are likely to be affected by the proposed rule" and adopt a "business impact statement" if the City's proposed rule will "directly restrict the formation, operation or expansion of a business."
