The City is looking for North Las Vegas residents to volunteer to serve on various boards, committees and commissions. If you are interested in helping shape the future of our City, we invite you to consider serving on one of these pivotal boards. Complete the form and sent or fax it to the City Clerk's Office. When an opening occurs, the City Council will review all applications and an appointment will be made at a regularly scheduled City Council meeting. Individuals appointed will be notified by the City Clerk's Office.

<p>1. <b>Arts and Culture Advisory Board:</b> To act as an advisory board to the Mayor and City Council on matters related to arts and culture in the City of North Las Vegas. Meets quarterly at publicly noticed date, time and place as voted on by the board.</p> <p>2. <b>Citizens Advisory Committee:</b> Makes recommendations for allocating Community Development Block Grant funds to meet the needs of low to moderate income groups through decent housing, developing viable communities and neighborhoods and promoting economic growth. Beginning in late November of each year through February, CAC meetings are held the first Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. in the City Hall building, or as needed.</p> <p>3. <b>Civil Service Board of Trustees:</b> Adjudicating board for City employee complaints. Meets the third Tuesday of each quarter (January, April, July and October) at 5:00 p.m. in the City Hall building, or as needed.</p> <p>4. <b>Library District Board of Trustees:</b> The governing/policy making authority for the North Las Vegas Library District. Regular meetings are held bimonthly on the fourth Tuesday of January, March, May, July, September and November at 5:00 p.m. in the City Hall building.</p> <p>5. <b>Parks and Recreation Advisory Board:</b> Provides input on recreation programs, parks maintenance issues, recreational facility locations and the need for new facilities. Regular meetings are held the second Tuesday of each month at 5:45 p.m. in the City Hall building.</p> <p>6. <b>Planning Commission:</b> Makes recommendations to the City Council on matters of planning and zoning; reviews and approves tentative maps, special use permits, variances, etc. Regular meetings are held the second Wednesday of the month at 6:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers.</p> <p>7. <b>Redevelopment Advisory Committee:</b> Studies, reviews, advises and makes recommendations to the Redevelopment Agency on policy matters concerning the designated redevelopment areas and neighborhood revitalization as requested by the Agency. Meetings are held in the City Hall building, as needed.</p>	<p>8. <b>Traffic and Parking Advisory Committee:</b> Reviews matters concerning the placement and removal of parking on City streets and other matters regarding traffic. Regular meetings are held on the second Monday of February, May, August and November at 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall building.</p> <p>9. <b>Utility Advisory Board:</b> Discusses information relevant to the water and wastewater utilities; reviews major changes to the water and wastewater utilities; reviews proposed water and wastewater rate increases and provides a recommendation to the City Council; gathers information from the citizens and its water service areas concerning the water and wastewater utilities through meetings, surveys and public forums. Regular meetings are held on the first Tuesday of April and October at 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall building.</p> <p>10. <b>Veterans Community Commission:</b> Acts as a formal advisory board to the Mayor and City Council on matters relating to veterans; support veteran-oriented special events and collaborative events that meet the needs of veterans; and serve as an advocacy body on behalf of veterans in the community. Meets the second Thursday of the month at 5:30 p.m. in the City Hall building.</p> <p>11. <b>County, Regional and State Boards:</b> Various boards and committees in which the City of North Las Vegas participates, including but not limited to: Clark County Community Development Advisory Committee, Regional Flood Control District Citizens Advisory Committee, Regional Transportation Commission Bus Stop Shelter Advisory Committee and Southern Nevada Regional Housing Authority.</p>
<p><b>The following committees are formed on as as-needed basis:</b></p>	
<p>12. <b>Mayor's Task Forces:</b> Various recommending bodies formed at the request of the Mayor. Appointments are made by the Mayor.</p> <p>13. <b>Ballot Question Advisory Committee (Ad hoc):</b> In the event of a ballot question, committees will be formed to develop arguments for and against passage. Note: This is an ad hoc, temporary committee that will be formed <b>only</b> in the event of a ballot question.</p>
