Low and moderate income household means a household having an income equal to or less than the Section 8 income limit established by HUD. A very low income household means a household having an income equal to or less than the Section 8 very low income (50%) established by HUD. An extremely low income household means a household whose income is 30% or less of the area median income adjusted for family size.
