**Low and moderate income household** means a household having an income equal to or less than the Section 8 income limit established by HUD. A **very low income household** means a household having an income equal to or less than the Section 8 very low income (50%) established by HUD. An **extremely low income household** means a household whose income is 30% or less of the area median income adjusted for family size.
