What will you do if you become a victim of a crime?

Knowing the right places to find the necessary resources to overcome the victimization can make a huge difference in your life.

The Victim Services Detail within the North Las Vegas Police Department has a variety of services available to the community to assist victims on all types of crimes.

These services include:

- Information and referrals to agencies that provide services for crime victims and/or family;
- Court assistance/accompaniment and support through the criminal justice process;
- Confidentiality of services;
- Assistance with filing Temporary Protection Order applications;
- Information and referral about the State of Nevada Victims of Crime Program;
- Up-to-date information about your case;
- Assistance with transportation to attend court hearings;
- Information about Safety Planning;
- Shelter placement assistance;
- Other services include referral to agencies that provide legal services for civil matters, such as child custody, divorce, evictions, etc.
