The City of North Las Vegas (City) is requesting bid proposals for the following Project:

FEDERAL STIMULUS - STREET REHABILITATION 2009-A

SCOPE OF WORK:

This project generally consists of the construction of pavement rehabilitation strategies for two aging arterial roadways, Lake Mead Boulevard - from Rancho Drive to Tonopah Drive and Pecos Road - from Colton Avenue to Las Vegas Boulevard. The method of rehabilitation for each roadway generally includes the removal and replacement of asphaltic concrete pavement and part of the underlying base course. Also included with this work are the removal, replacement, and/or installation of sidewalk ramps, detectable warning panels, spandrels, sidewalk, curb and gutter, cross gutters, quadrupole loop detectors, pavement markings and striping, adjusting manholes and water valves, and all other appurtenances pertaining thereto. All work will be done in compliance with the Department of Justice (DOJ) 28 CFR, P36, rev 7/1/94.

Engineer's Construction Estimate
Base Bid = \$3,760,000 to \$4,745,000

The Project shall be completed within one-hundred twenty (120) consecutive calendar days from the date specified in the Notice to Proceed, which time shall include resolution of all punch list items, final cleanup, and demobilization.

A PREBID CONFERENCE will be held on September 16, 2009, at 10:00 a.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall Complex, 2200 Civic Center Drive, North Las Vegas, NV 89030. The purpose of this conference is to discuss the Project, prospective bidders concerns, and key issues. Prospective bidders are encouraged to attend, but attendance is not mandatory. For special assistance or accommodations at this pre-bid conference, please contact the ADA coordinator at (702) 633-1510 at least 72 hours in advance.

BID OPENING: All Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope, plainly marked, as detailed in Paragraph E, of the Instructions to Bidders, Section IB.1. All bids must be received in the office of the City Clerk, City Hall Complex, 2200 Civic Center Drive, North Las Vegas, NV 89030, prior to 2:00 p.m., local time, on October 6, 2009. The official time will be per the City Clerk's office without exception. Bids received and stamped after the designated time will not be considered and will be returned to the Bidder unopened. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in the City Council Chambers, City Hall Complex, immediately after the established closing time and date. BID DOCUMENTS will be available on September 9, 2009 and may be obtained at the Public Works Department, Engineering Division, 2266 Civic Center Drive, North Las Vegas, NV 89030, for a non-refundable fee of \$60.00. The Bid Documents can also be retrieved through DemandStar.com. If documents are to be mailed, there will be a \$50.00 postage and handling fee. This is a Federal-aid project so any Contractor, otherwise qualified by the State of Nevada to perform such work, is not required to be licensed nor to submit application for license in advance of submitting a bid or having such bid considered. However, the Contractor determined to be the successful bidder shall obtain the required license in accordance with the provisions of NRS Chapter 624 prior to executing the contract.


Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, plainly marked with the bidder's name and address in the lower left-hand corner, the bid number, the opening date and time, and accompanied by the sealed Bid Proposal, Bid Schedule, Subcontractor Listing, Material Supplier Listing, Bid Bond, Non-Collusive Affidavit, Americans with Disabilities Act Statement, Recovery Act Language and Notice to Contractors, Required Contract Provisions - Federal-Aid Construction Contracts, Additional Contract Provisions - Supplement to the Weekly Certified Payrolls, Standard Federal Equal Employment Opportunity Construction Contract Specifications (Executive Order 11246), Additional Contract Provisions - Specific Equal Employment Opportunity Responsibilities, Additional Contract Provisions - Minority Business Enterprise in Federal-Aid Highway Construction, Affidavit Required under Section 112(c) of Title 23 USC and Part 29 of Title 49 CFR, Certification Required by Section 1352 of Title 31 USC, and Disclosure of Lobbying Activities.

The City Council of the City of North Las Vegas reserves the right to reject any or all bids or waive any informality in a bid. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 90 days after the date set for the opening thereof. Acceptance, rejection, and other requirements of bidders are subject to the NRS Chapter 338, as amended.
