



BUILDING SAFETY OUTREACH

In the summer of 2009, Building Safety initiated a Permit Amnesty Program. The program enabled homeowners to acquire permits for pre-existing, non-permitted structures, without the usual fines, citations or double permit fees and obtain a free code-compliance inspection, if needed. Many of the citizens who attended the free amnesty seminar completed customer surveys and indicated their request for more information/education on how to improve their properties.

Committed to improving services for our community and in answer to citizen requests, Building Safety established the Community Outreach Program. This program provides training and information in both English and Spanish on various aspects of complying with basic code and city requirements for safe construction.

The Outreach Program provides an informational booth at the local Broad Acres Swap Meet on the last Friday and Saturday of each month. Various training presentations and informational sessions will be provided as well to teach and inform the local community of the resources available to them for improving their homes and our community. In addition, Building Safety will conduct various seminars at the local Boys and Girls Club, located at 2530 East Carey Avenue.
