1. **DISCUSSION AND DIRECTION TO STAFF REGARDING THE PROPOSED 2006 JAZZ FESTIVAL TO BE HELD AT CRAIG RANCH GOLF COURSE, LOCATED AT 628 WEST CRAIG ROAD.**

City Manager Gregory Rose stated the City had received a proposal from Michael Schivo Presents to use the Craig Ranch Golf Course for the 14th Annual Las Vegas City of Lights Jazz and R & B Festival. Mr. Schivo had requested the City co-sponsor the event, which Staff had estimated would cost the City approximately \$64,530. City Manager Rose stated he did not recommend approval because the event was not open to the public.

Parks and Recreation Director Mike Henley outlined the costs the City would incur to allow the event, which included \$4,500 for police, including overtime, \$43,800 in costs for Parks and Recreation assistance and loss of revenue at the golf course, \$12,000 for fire and emergency medical coverage and \$4,230 for traffic control.

Steve Schivo, the applicant, described the event and stated it was a long standing and well known event throughout the United States and Europe. He believed the cost to the City to sponsor the event was less than what Staff had described.

Councilman Buck asked if the Festival could be called the North Las Vegas Jazz Festival and Mr. Schivo stated it could not because it was already advertised and known by the Las Vegas name.

Councilman Buck stated it was too soon to discuss changes to the Craig Ranch Golf Course and she suggested considering the event in two or three years, after the decisions about what to do with the property were made.

Mr. Schivo asked that the item be withdrawn from further consideration.
