- 1) A/Chief Forti and Sgt. Dan Lake gave a tour of the new Justice Complex.
- 2) Chief Paresi handed out the Vision 2025 Strategic Plan and asked that we take a look at it. The plan is a roadmap for the City. Please read it and see what you can come up with as a group.
