

In February, 2009, Congress passed the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. Among other stimulus activities, the ARRA authorized a new, one-time appropriation of funds to help prevent homelessness in these trying times.

The funds can be used to help households that have fallen into homelessness, but are otherwise stable and could succeed in private market housing with a little assistance.

The new funds are called Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program funds, or HPRP. They are a one-time appropriation, to be spent within three (3) years.

City of North Las Vegas households experiencing hardship in this economic downturn can be assisted with \$677,704 in these Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program funds (or, HPRP funds).
