STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Water Reclamation Facility (WRF) is a state-of-the-art facility using submerged membrane bioreactor technology to produce clear reclaimable water. The alarm system is required to maintain a secure and safe facility 24 hours a day and avoid burglary, theft and fire.

The WRF currently has a service agreement with Tyco Integrated Security, LLC for \$24,000 per year for alarm monitoring which expires in May of 2018. Tyco is offering an incentive for renewing the agreement for five years at \$18,000 per year which is an annual savings of \$6,000 and a savings of \$30,000 over five years. The agreement includes 24 hour video surveillance inside and outside the Water Reclamation Facility and perimeter fence. Service calls and replacement batteries for the alarm system are also included.

It is staff's recommendation that City Council approve the Alarm Monitoring Services Agreement with Tyco Integrated Security, LLC for a five year term for an amount not to exceed \$90,000.
