<p>That the Library Board approve the suggested standard trespass language below for all North Las Vegas Library District Branches.</p> <p>“As a duly appointed representative of the owner of this property, I hereby warn you that you are trespassing upon this property as defined by the Nevada Revised Statute 207.200. If you do not leave these premises immediately, you will be subject to arrest for a misdemeanor. Your subsequent return to the premises after being duly warned not to return will subject you to immediate arrest for trespassing. You are hereby asked to leave the library and you may not return to any North Las Vegas Library District property.”</p>
