The City of North Las Vegas (City) is requesting bid proposals for the following Project:

TROPICAL PARKWAY IMPROVEMENTS

SCOPE OF WORK:

The work general involves construction of roadway improvements from the intersection of CC-215 and Tropical Parkway east to the intersection of Tropical Parkway and Linn Lane and then south on Linn Lane to the intersection of Linn Lane and El Campo Grande Avenue. Roadway improvements will include construction of roadway embankment, excavation, grading, concrete barrier rail, storm drain culverts and headwalls, storm drainage collection system, bituminous asphalt pavement, raised medians, concrete ADA ramps at intersections, bituminous asphalt sidewalk on the north side of Tropical Parkway and the east side of Linn Lane, water line and sewer line and appurtenances. Additionally, a street lighting system will be installed on Tropical Parkway, including 4-Inch FAST conduit, striping, signage, vertical adjustment of utilities and associated appurtenances inherent in roadway and flood control work.

The Project is federally funded subject to both the Davis-Bacon and state prevailing wage requirements. The Contractor shall pay each employee the higher rate of either the Clark County prevailing wage rate or the Davis-Bacon wage rates at each trade position.

The Project shall be completed within **two hundred forty (240) consecutive calendar days** from the date specified in the Notice to Proceed, which time shall include resolution of all punch list items, final cleanup and demobilization.

The estimated monetary range of the project is: **\$3,500,000 to \$4,500,000**.

A PREBID CONFERENCE will be held on Tuesday, May 9, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. in Room 630, City Hall, 2250 Las Vegas Blvd. North, Suite 610 (6th Floor), North Las Vegas, NV 89030. BID OPENING: All Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope, plainly marked, as detailed in Paragraph E, of the Instructions to Bidders, Section IB.1. All bids must be received in the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 2250 Las Vegas Blvd. North, Suite 800 (8th Floor), North Las Vegas, NV 89030, prior to 2:00 p.m., local time, on Wednesday, May 31, 2017. The official time will be per the City Clerk's office without exception. Bids received and stamped after the designated time will not be considered and will be returned to the Bidder unopened. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in Room 630, City Hall, 2250 Las Vegas Blvd. North, Suite 610 (6th Floor), North Las Vegas, NV 89030, immediately after the established closing time and date. The non-refundable fee for printed copies is \$100. A Geotechnical Report, which is a reference document and is not part of this Contract, will be available for \$25. If documents are to be mailed, there is a \$75 postage and handling fee. Only checks can be accepted and are to be made payable to the City of North Las Vegas.

Bidders for this Work must be qualified and properly licensed for this particular work by the Nevada State Contractor's Board, and licensed to do business in the City of North Las Vegas prior to the award of Bid by City Council. Failure to comply will result in rejection of the Bid. Nevada Contractor's License classification, number, and dollar limit must be indicated on the Bid Proposal, if available. Questions concerning license requirements shall be directed to the Nevada State Contractor's Board. Bidders and the successful Contractor and Subcontractors shall comply with all provisions of Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 624 and Nevada Administrative Code, Chapter 624.

Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, plainly marked with the bidder's name and address in the lower left-hand corner, the bid number, the opening date and time, and accompanied by the sealed Bid Proposal, Bid Schedule, Subcontractor Listing, Suppliers Listing, Bid Bond, Non-Collusive Affidavit, Americans with Disabilities Statement, Required Contract Provisions – Federal-Aid Construction Contracts, Additional Contract Provisions – Supplement to the Weekly Certified Payrolls, Standard Federal Equal Employment Opportunity Construction – Contract Specification (Executive Order 11246), Additional Contract Provision – Specific Equal Employment Opportunity Responsibilities, Additional Contract Provisions – Minority Business Enterprise in Federal-Aid Highway Construction, Affidavit Required Under Section 112(c) of Title 23 United States Code, Act of August 27, 1958 and Part 29 of Title 49 – Code of Federal Regulations, Certification Required by Section 1352 of Title 31, U.S. Code, and Disclosure of Lobbying Activities.

This is a Federal-Aid project so any contractor, otherwise qualified by the State of Nevada to perform such work, is not required to be licensed nor to submit application for license in advance of submitting a bid or having such bid considered. However, the contractor determined to be the successful bidder shall obtain the required license in accordance with the provisions of NRS Chapter 624 prior to executing the contract.

The City Council of the City of North Las Vegas reserves the right to reject any or all bids or waive any informality in a bid. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 120 days after the date set for the opening thereof. Acceptance, rejection, and other requirements of bidders are subject to the NRS Chapter 338, as amended.

The City is an Equal Opportunity Employer and women-owned and minority business enterprises are strongly encouraged to bid.
