The City of North Las Vegas (City) is requesting bid proposals for the following Project:

SCOPE OF WORK: Construction of a reinforced concrete box (RCB) storm drain and open channel system in Hollywood Boulevard from 400 feet north of Las Vegas Boulevard to Munitions Road on Nellis Air Force Base property, and a riprap-lined and earthen channel to daylight. Work involves construction of storm drain facilities comprised of single- and multi-cell RCBs; reinforced concrete rectangular open channels; confluence, transition, and inlet flume structures; reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) lateral storm drains; drop inlets with aprons; and manholes. Other associated improvements include relocation of a 16-inch water line; relocation of 20-inch, 12-inch, and 10-inch sanitary sewer lines; installation of steel casings and concrete caps; installation of security fence, access control grate, post and cable fence, and tortoise fencing; removal and reconstruction of bituminous pavement, curb and gutter, pavement markings; and other appurtenances associated with urban flood control facility construction.

The work includes construction under the terms of the NDOT Occupancy Agreements for work in Las Vegas Boulevard and construction on Nellis Air Force Base property under the terms of Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Form 7460-1 and a City agreement with the Air Force.

The Project shall be completed within **450 consecutive calendar days** from the date specified in the Notice to Proceed, in which time shall include resolution of all punch list items, final cleanup and demobilization.

The estimated monetary range of the project is: **\$16,000,000 to \$19,000,000.**

A PREBID CONFERENCE will be held on Tuesday, July 9, 2019, at 10:00 a.m. in Room 630, City Hall, 2250 Las Vegas Blvd. North, Suite 610 (6th Floor), North Las Vegas, NV 89030. The purpose of this conference is to discuss the Project, prospective bidders' concerns, and key issues. **Although the meeting is not mandatory, perspective bidders are encouraged to attend.**

BID OPENING: All Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope, plainly marked, as detailed in Paragraph E, of the Instructions to Bidders, Section IB.1. All bids must be received in the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 2250 Las Vegas Blvd. North, Suite 800 (8th Floor), North Las Vegas, NV 89030, **prior to 2:00 p.m.**, local time, on **Wednesday, July 24, 2019.** The official time will be per the City Clerk's office without exception. Bids received and stamped after the designated time will not be considered and will be returned to the Bidder unopened. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in Room 630, City Hall, 2250 Las Vegas Blvd. North, Suite 610 (6th Floor), North Las Vegas, NV 89030, immediately after the established closing time and date.
