

FAST FACTS

Where is the park?

The park is at 628 West Craig Road, North Las Vegas, with entrance off Revere Street and Craig Road.

How big is the park?

The park is approximately 170 acres.

What are the park hours?

Park hours are from 6 am to 11 pm, 7 days per week.

Is there a charge for the park?

Access to the park is free.

Are there playgrounds?

The park has two large playgrounds – the Adventure Playground and the Pioneer Playground – that total 5 full acres of rock climbing, water play, slides and more.

Are volunteer opportunities available?

Yes, interest cards are available at the park information kiosk located in the park.

How do I reserve a Community Garden plot?

Gardeners may reserve a planter-box. Applications are available at the park information kiosk located in the park or at the park office at 851 W. Lone Mountain Road.

Is the park Wi-Fi accessible?

Yes.

Who designed the skate park?

What are the skate park hours?

Skate and BMX park hours are 8 am to 11 pm, 7 days per week.

Can I use my bike at the skate park?

Yes.

Can I reserve a tennis court?

Yes, through the information kiosk or at the park office at 851 W. Lone Mountain Road.

How do I reserve a picnic shelter or plaza?

Reservations can be made at the park office at 851 W. Lone Mountain Road, at the park information kiosk, on the City's website at www.cityofnorthlasvegas.com or by phone at (702) 633-2418.

Can I fish in the lakes?

Fishing is not permitted in the park.

Can I reserve sections of the park for events?

Yes, contact the reservation desk at (702) 633-2418.

Is my event able to serve/sell beer and wine?

Alcohol is prohibited in the park. Beer and wine may be served / sold with an approved permit. A permit may be obtained through the reservation desk (702) 633-2418.

Is there a special rate for non-profits?

Parks services are set at one rate for all.

Can I bring my own BBQ and/or ice chests?

Although you may not bring your own grill to the park, charcoal barbeque grills are available on a first-come, first served basis at picnic sites and group shelters. Ice chests are welcome.

What are the dog park hours?

The dog park is open Thursday through Tuesday 6 am to 11 pm and Wednesday from 8 am to 11 pm.

Are there ball fields?

There are two 275' game fields. They have covered dugouts, live turf out-fields and DG in-fields. The site includes restrooms, concession facility and plaza.

Are there any future development plans for the park?

Planning for phase III includes an amphitheater, multi-use fields, swim lagoon and a multi-purpose building.

Are there recycle opportunities in the park?

Yes, green receptacles have been placed at various locations within the park.
