

McCool Regional Park Fly Field **Incident Reporting Procedures**

- Flying Hours:
 - a. Fuel Powered Aircraft:
 - Monday – Thursday 8am – 1 pm
 - Friday & Saturday 8am – 8 pm
 - b. Electronic Powered Aircraft:
 - Daily 8am – 8pm
- The City conducts random sound checks and will attempt to investigate all reported violations, including but not limited to: flight zone infraction, trespassing, plane registration, and membership card violations.
- Reporting Offenders/Incidents:

You have three options:

1. Electronically file an “e-police report” TIP online through the City website. Log on at:
<http://www.cityofnorthlasvegas.com/Departments/Police/ePRIndex.htm>.
Select “Submit a Tip” and follow the instructions.
2. Call the City’s Police non emergency phone number 311.

Be prepared to provide a detailed description of the incident (date, time, description of the aircraft and details of the incident). Response to your call by a uniformed police officer, a member of the City’s Volunteer in Policing (VIP), or recreation staff will depend on the following:

- a. Type of incident.
 - b. How the reported incident is prioritized against other competing calls for service.
 - c. Availability of VIP participants.
3. Call (702) 633-1629. This number contacts Neighborhood Recreation Center. If the Center is open the phone will be answered. If closed, a message may be left in the voicemail inbox. Messages are checked each morning the Center is open. You will be called back at the earliest possible opportunity.
