## OPEN RECRUITMENT FOR SCHOOL CROSSING GUARDS (2015-2016 SCHOOL YEAR)

The North Las Vegas Police Department is recruiting a number of School Crossing Guards for positions at various elementary schools throughout the City of North Las Vegas. Crossing Guards are responsible for assisting our young students safely across busy intersections on their way to and from school. This is a great part-time position for the right person!

- Crossing Guards are part-time/per diem employees paid \$9.00 an hour.
- Typical hours range between 6:45 and 9:15 each morning and 1:50 and 4:00 each afternoon when school is in regular session. Scheduled shift times depend on which school location you are assigned to.
- Training and equipment are provided

The position of a crossing guard is not without some risk. Working alone around traffic and being on your feet outside in the Nevada climate, even for only one hour, is not for everyone.

However, if you are looking for an opportunity to make every day a safer one for the children of our community and you are prepared to commit to be on the job promptly each day school is in session, this could be the job for you.
