City of North Las Vegas Bid B1556 Tree Trimming Services Addendum No. 1

The deadline for questions for this proposal was 12:00 p.m., Monday December 5, 2018. The following are the questions that were received and answers to those questions. Also attached is a copy of the sign in roster from the Pre Bid meeting conducted on November 21, 2018. A copy of this addendum must be signed and returned with your proposal.

- **Question 1**. Who provides any new trees that may need to be purchased under this contract? Answer: The Selected vendor will provide the trees. Prices for trees should be included in your "planting" Bid amount.
- **Question 2**. Please redefine the difference between Priority 1 and Priority 2? Answer: Priority 1 is defined as emergency work that if left unattended would threaten the safety of personnel or property (ie. significant weather event). Priority 2 is all other work.
- **Question 3**. What is "structure pruning"? Answer: This is pruning that develops/improves the structure of the tree. Pruning should be performed to improve plant architecture (i.e. Desirable branch size, spacing, diameter and aspect ratios). Ensure that the plant is compatible with the site (e.g. Minimize conflict with traffic, site lines or infrastructure), and or to restore damaged plants.
- Question 4. How deep beneath the surface should we go when doing stump removals? Answer: 4 to 6 inches.
- **Question 5.** To clarify, there is not a total number or quantity of trees associated with this Bid. We are bidding a unit price to trees based on the size and caliper of the tree. A representative from the City will determine what trees he wants trimmed, review the scope of work with our personnel, and authorize that work and price accordingly. Is this correct? *Answer:* Yes.
- Question 6. How high up should the tree caliper be measured? Answer: The basis will be the trees diameter breast height which is the circumference of the tree, measured in inches at 4 and ½ feet up from the ground, divided by 3.14.
- Question 7. Should there be a price to excavate the root ball of a removed tree if the new tree is to be planted in the exact location? Answer: Root ball removal will be on a case by case basis and will be as determined by the City. We anticipate planting new trees near existing root balls on most occasions.
- **Question 8.** Should there be a price for 19' 24' tree removal? *Answer: This is an administrative error.* Please see the Revised Attachment A for the updated correction.

Question 9. Should there not be two (2) 25' – 30' Priority 1 Pruning items? *Answer: This is an administrative error. Please see the Revised Attachment A for the updated correction.*
